Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Queenstown Central Brewing Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at **8/12 Industrial Place, Queenstown**, and known as **Searchlight Brewery** to any person for consumption off the premises, and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

If this licence is not endorsed under section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:


- a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00pm on Anzac Day.
- b) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape wine or fruit or vegetable wine made
 - i) on the premises; or
 - ii) from grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated.
- c) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 11.00am to 10.00pm
- d) Drinking water must be freely available whenever free samples of alcohol are being supplied.
- e) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed: display of appropriate signs detailing the statutory restrictions of the supply of alcohol to minors and the prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons, identification of minors.
- f) According to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol (Fees) Regulations 2013 the premises is assigned the fees category: **Medium-Tavern.**

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force

- a) Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
- b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed.
